

HMIS Transitional Housing Workflow using ShelterPoint

Transitional Housing is designed to provide homeless individuals and families with the interim stability and support to successfully move to and maintain permanent housing. Transitional housing may be used to cover the costs of up to 24 months of housing with accompanying supportive services. Program participants must have a lease (or sublease) or occupancy agreement in place when residing in transitional housing. Services and Updates can happen out of order but must come after project start and before project exit. A project may have multiple Services and/or Updates.
